#### Look, here is water! Here is our water of life! Alleluia!



## Gospel: John 15:9-17



#### NICENE CREED

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. 
## LORD'S PRAYER






